Born: October 22, 1859, New York City.
Died: January 10, 1924, Brooklyn, NY.

Details on Isaac Hattenbach, his wife Rachel, and their time in Leadville are very limited. Isaac was born in Hamburg, Prussia, during 1838. He immigrated to the United States through New York City in 1865.¹ From there Isaac seems to have taken a path westward in short segments with brief

stops in New Mexico,² Central City, and Leadville, Colorado, while periodically returning to New York for interim periods before settling there permanently in 1883.³

Isaac was a bachelor in 1879 when he first arrived in Leadville. He opened shop as a saloonkeeper who operated his own storefront on the southwest corner of 2nd Street and Harrison.⁴ He did not stay in Leadville long, although he did participate in a fundraiser for the B'nai B'rith in 1879.⁵ During the winter of 1880, Isaac returned to New York City and married Rachel Cohn there on February 8th.⁶ It is unclear whether the couple ever returned to Leadville.
